Presented in person at the venue and online. Details will be announced soon.

[3] Poster presentation (On-Demand only)

Submitted as a PDF.

- ·Presentations are accepted in both English and Japanese.
- •Presenters from both [2] and [3] qualify to be chosen for the Best Poster Prize and the Encouragement Prize. Voting among participants will take place on the day of the conference.
- •The presenters of [2] are also required to submit their posters as PDFs in order for online participants to view.
- For [2] and [3], it is acceptable to present a doctoral dissertation proposal. In such cases, please use the following format "Title: Subtitle (Doctoral dissertation work-in-progress)" on the application form.
